



A PARENT'S GUIDE TO ROBLOX SAFETY

Youth First is committed to digital safety as the popularity of gaming and tech is on the rise among youth. This guide is intended to help parents and caregivers establish safe and fun gaming experiences for children.

THE FOUNDATION: LINKED ACCOUNTS

Roblox now allows parents to manage settings from their own devices. Do not just set up the child's account; link it to yours.

1. Create Your Account: Sign up for a parent account at Roblox.com.
2. Verify Identity: Use the "Parental Controls" tab to verify you are an adult.
3. Link: Send a request to your child's username to become their "Authorized Parent."

THE BIG FOUR: CRITICAL SETTINGS

Once linked, go to your Parent Dashboard and configure these settings:

Feature	Recommended Setting	Purpose
Experience Chat	"Friends Only" or "Off"	Prevents strangers from talking to your child in-game.
2. Content Maturity	"Minimal" or "Mild"	Filters out scary, violent, or "dating" style games.
3. Spending Limit	Set a Monthly Cap	Prevents accidental \$100 charges on your credit card.
4. Screen Time	Set Daily Limit	The app will automatically lock after the time is up.

THE "RED FLAG" RULES FOR KIDS

Copy and post these rules near your child's computer/tablet:

1. **NO PII:** Never give out your Personal Identifiable Information (Name, School, Age, Address).
2. **STAY ON ROBLOX:** Never move a conversation to Discord, Snapchat, or Instagram.
3. **NO FREE ROBUX:** Any site promising "Free Robux" is a scam designed to steal your account.
4. **THE RED FLAG:** If someone makes you feel weird, uncomfortable, or asks you to keep a secret, block them and tell an adult immediately.

MONITORING CHECKLIST

1. Check the Friends List: Are there any names you don't recognize?
2. Review "Recently Played": See which games your child spends the most time in.
3. Enable Spend Notifications: Get an email every time a purchase is made.

HOW TO REPORT A PLAYER

1. Click the Roblox Icon in the top-left corner of the game screen.
2. Select the Flag Icon next to the user's name.
